HOMEMADE SNOWGLOBE

JAN 19TH

In this session, when it's too cold to be outside, we'll make our own miniature snowscape. We'll even add some snow of our own. We'll also talk about how plants need help with the cold, and the protection a layer of fluffy snow can provide.



SUCCULENTS

FEB 16TH

In this session we'll work with some of the trendiest plants around...succulents! Everyone loves them, why? We'll talk about that as well as how they grow. Did you know you can propagate new succulents from a single leaf?



GRASS PETS

MAR 16TH

We'll be crafty AND fun as we learn about seed germination and plant some hair on the heads of our "grass pets". We'll look at some different kinds of seeds and see how they're different. Then we'll go home with some seeds we can observe and watch sprout.



SEED STARTING

APR 20TH

In this session we'll continue our discussion on seeds and talk about what they need to germinate, the plants they become and the food many provide. We'll plant some seeds you can continue to grow outside and grow your own food!

MAY 18TH

In this session we'll plant our own pot of flowers and even go home with a pack of our own. Plant them in the ground or in a pot. We'll also discuss the four basic needs of plants, can you name them?

JUN 15TH

Nothing is as much fun as creating your very own pet. Does it have two eyes, six eyes, or maybe six legs. In this session we'll talk about the many different kinds of insects and how they help and hinder us!

NOV 16TH

In this session we'll examine various leaves and the colors they turn. We'll build our own miniature tree out of branches. We'll write messages of what we're thankful for on the leaves and place them on our own "Thankful Tree" that we'll take home.

WINTER FAIRY GARDEN

DEC 14TH
